The Ahaki Institute is excited to announce a unique opportunity to join our Mentorship Programme, designed to nurture the next generation of African leaders in these critical fields.

Mentorship Programme Overview:

Afya na Haki Institute is offering a 6-month growth-propelling mentorship programme, on; **“Navigating the complexities arising from global politics and policies on Reproductive Justice in Africa”** for early career professionals on the continent. This mentorship programme focuses on how to navigate complexities arising from Global politics and policies on reproductive justice in Africa.

Restrictive foreign policies initiated and backed by the U.S. government such as the Global Gag Rule, and Geneva Consensus Declaration have gravely impacted SRHR implementation, services, advocacy and work in Africa. These policies restrict access to SRHR care and services, disrupt partnerships and collaborations, and restrict rights and freedoms such as speech, information, health, non-discrimination, and association, among others.

The mentorship programme will empower mentees with strategies and skills to thrive amidst restrictive global politics and policies affecting reproductive justice within the continent. The programme will commence in April 2025.

Structure:

Mentees will be paired with mentors who specialise in their field of interest. The program will operate in a flexible yet structured way, combining virtual and in-person interactions. It will also include internships and externships to enhance the mentees' experience. The programme will culminate in the Annual Mentorship Conference.
